Character and Abilities - The Senior Pastor of Riverlands Church, Gayndah will...

- 3. Demonstrate a clear testimony of faith and devotion to Christ and His church.
- 4. Exemplify the biblical leadership qualities of an elder/pastor as broadly defined in 1 Timothy and Titus.
- 5. Maintain a strong personal devotional life of worship, prayer, and study of God's Word.
- 6. Model a lifestyle of adherence to biblical standards of morality, ethics, and the fruit of the Spirit.
- 7. Have a passion for people and for reaching the lost and broken, and a strong desire to see people find freedom and wholeness in Christ Jesus.
- 8. Possess strong interpersonal skills, being able to relate to all age groups.
- 9. Value team engagement and have a proven track record of working well with others, as well as being committed to a team approach to ministry.
- 10. Possess the ability to preach clear, engaging, Gospel-centered messages with relevant application to the congregation.
- 11. Have an understanding of, and embrace, the culture of a country church and community.

Responsibilities – The Senior Pastor of Riverlands Church, Gayndah will...

- 1. In partnership with the church eldership, develop and implement the church vision.
- 2. Provide vision, understanding, encouragement, and oversight for the congregation.
- 3. Plan and orchestrate Sunday service/s, working together with the service team coordinator, eldership and worship leader. This includes the preparation of the preaching schedule.
- 4. Organise and lead, and/or equip and release others to lead, prayer meetings, Bible studies, small groups, discipleship programs etc for the purpose of edification and evangelism.
- 5. Identify, motivate, mentor, equip, train, oversee and empower the ministry potential of those within the congregation.
- 6. Provide, facilitate, and/or organise pastoral care for congregation members. This includes modelling a high level of pastoral care, as well as encouraging, developing and supporting others to do so. This includes hospital visitation.
- 7. Make themselves available and accessible to members of the congregation and community during flexible working hours.
- 8. Engage with the wider Gayndah community and explore avenues/participate in activities that will assist the Church in being influential and a blessing.
- 9. Identify, develop, and/or organise ministry opportunities for edification and outreach and to build community within the church.
- 10. Participate in ongoing education and training opportunities that will enhance their own ministerial understanding and ability.
- 11. Provide personal, pre-marital, marital, crisis and conflict resolution counseling in a safe and professional setting, being aware of their limitations and referring to professionals when necessary. Also facilitating church disciplinary matters, in agreement with the eldership.
- 12. Officiating weddings, funerals, baby dedications, water baptisms etc.
- 13. Chair the Management Committee meetings and Annual General Meetings of Riverlands Church, Gayndah.
- 14. Together with the eldership and leadership team, facilitate and participate in annual reviews to assess the previous year and determine direction for the next 12 months.
